#### **The Big Picture**



Here's the simple way to think about it:


Copilot - great for quick tasks right inside Excel.

Agent Mode - builds out full workbooks from a single prompt.

Copilot Studio and Agent Flows - take it further across the Microsoft stack.


## **Copilot - Your Everyday Helper**



Copilot helps you clean data, write formulas, summarize trends, and build quick visuals. It's perfect when you're already in the workbook and just need a boost.

Think of it as your built-in problem-solver, not a replacement for your brain.

## **Agent Mode - The Builder**




Agent Mode can spin up an entire dashboard, model, or report from one prompt.

It links formulas, creates charts, writes explanations, and structures everything for you. It's great for prototyping or starting something new from scratch.

#### **Copilot Studio and Agent Flows - The Connectors**



This is where it gets powerful. Copilot Studio lets you create agents that connect Excel to other Microsoft apps like Teams, Power BI, and Outlook.

Agent Flows combine Power Automate logic with AI, so your automations can actually think before they act.
